I am terrified that if I have to return to Cameroon, the government would again imprison and torture me, and even kill me, for my political opinions.

Cameroon. Cameroonian police disrupted one of these meetings, beating some of the people attending the meeting. I had to run away to escape being beaten. In January 2018 I gave out flyers from the SCNC for a "Ghost Town Day" to be held on February 11, 2018. I gave them to fellow students at the University of Buea. After that, Cameroonian police arrested, imprisoned, and tortured me because I had distributed those flyers.

The Cameroonian police already arrested, imprisoned and tortured me for my political opinions, including severely beating me, tying me up and repeatedly almost drowning me, and imprisoning me in very crowded conditions without food and water. I am terrified that if I had to return to Cameroon they would torture me again, and even kill me, because of my political activities on behalf of the SCNC.
